### A message from the Head of School.



#### **School Council.**



The left over money from the Movie Night, run alongside the Little Peoples Council, will be used to give each class an Easter treat of crafts and chocolates towards.





### SHORT TERM MEASURE ADVISED BY PUBLIC HEALTH PROTECTION UNIT.
