As you are aware our topic this term is "Julia Donaldson" and this week we have been learning all about the story of "Tiddler".

The activities have included a board game to help Tiddler get home, decorating fish and creating an underwater scene using lots of different materials. The writing activity this week has been to write some of the tales Tiddler told for being late to school. We have seen some wonderful pieces of writing this week!

In phonics, we have been revisiting our learnt sounds and they have been reading some books. We are seeing great progress in their writing and their reading.
