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ORCHARD VALE SPEEDING PROJECT



Yesterday between 1.45pm – 2.45pm the new OV Active Travel Team took part in a speeding project which involved working alongside our local

PCSO's. The aim of the project was to discover how many people drive over the 30mph speed limit through Whiddon Valley and the 20mph limit approaching Orchard Vale.

The team split into two groups (one group each side of the road) and assisted by PCSO's and OV staff individually held the speed gun whilst another child recorded the speed of vehicles approaching the



school. If a vehicle was speeding, the PCSO would pull the car over and speak with the driver. If appropriate the children would then take in turns to ask

the driver questions.

For example,

Do you know you are speeding?

Why are you speeding?

Do you know the speed limit approaching our school?

Do you think we need more signage informing drivers they are approaching a school?

How would you feel if your car hit a child?

The project was a huge success and the children who took part enjoyed tackling an important issue and being part of finding a solution. Due to its success we are delighted to inform you the Police would like to support us again by running more speeding projects at Orchard Vale.

In the next newsletter the Travel Team will reveal the results from the project and what their next plan of action is!

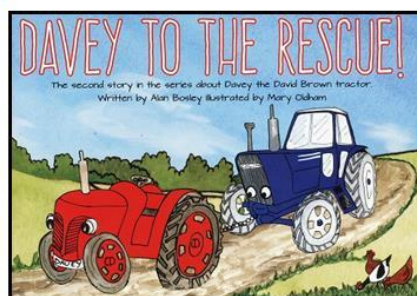
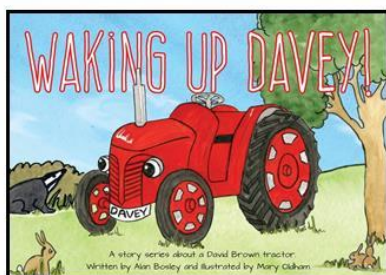
