

Curriculum Overview Reception.

This term the children have enjoyed looking at the author Julia Donaldson for our topic. We have explored a wide range of her books which are great for introducing rhyming and a variety of vocabulary to the children.

We have also linked many creative opportunities to her books, the children produced some fantastic Gruffalo paintings and made some lovely animal masks from Monkey Puzzle story.



We have started our Forest School sessions again this term and the children have enjoyed bug hunts and bark rubbing so far this term.



We have also been really impressed with the children's writing so far this term. They are now all writing a piece

weekly and lots of them are now able to write sentences with only a little support.

In Maths we have continued to revisit recognising numerals to 20, doing this everyday has had a massive positive effect on all the children's numeral recognition. The children have also done a fantastic job of understanding addition and subtraction and are now using vocabulary linked to this in their problem solving.
