I would like to thank all the children who have attended my sports clubs this year! As always, the uptake has been excellent and all children have been a pleasure to have.

Please look out for new clubs which will begin in September.

Price Changes as from 1st September 2023

We need to inform all parents that, after careful consideration, we are having to increase the cost of:

Breakfast Club - £3.50 per child/per day (£3 for siblings)

After School Club – OV Explorers - £7 per child/per day

School meals - the cost of a meal will be £2.50.

This decision has not been taken lightly, but with the significantly higher costs we are now facing for our gas and electric, along with the food and non-food inflationary costs increasing by over 12%, we are now at the point where we need to reflect these in our price costs.

We fully understand how difficult times are, therefore, we have tried to keep the increase as small as possible. As a nation we are all hoping that food and utility costs stabilise or potentially drop in the months ahead but as a precaution we will be undertaking a further review of meal prices in spring 2024.

The Government has continued to support the Universal Infant Free School Meals project, and this means that all the children, from Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can be provided with a school meal free of charge.

If your child is in Years 3-6, they can also have a free school meal if you are in receipt of certain allowances. Please contact the school office for information or help in completing forms.

If there is a difficulty in providing payment for meals, please contact the school office as soon as possible. All queries and requests for support are confidential and we will always work with families to ensure find the best solution we can.

Nursery and Little Seeds fees remain the same.

Thank you for your support and understanding.

Is your child eligible for Free School Meals?

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If you are eligible for benefit related Free School Meals and your child is registered for this on our pupil records? You will be receiving your voucher codes next week to redeem for supermarket vouchers for the summer holidays. If you think you may be eligible for benefit related Free School Meals you should complete an application on the Devon County Council website using the Citizens Portal Citizen Portal - Sign in (devon.gov.uk).

If you have applied, and it is confirmed you are eligible, please let us know as soon as possible so we can verify this and have time to obtain additional voucher codes from Devon County Council. The deadline date for this is the 25th July 2023.

Any children who are eligible for benefit related Free School Meals will have already received a letter with a code for the Devon County Council Holiday Activity and Food funded activities; there are limited spaces available for you to book over the summer holidays. These are booked following the instructions on the letter you were sent with the code and are administered by Devon County Council. Only one letter is sent with a code that covers the length of the HAF project.
