Maths Task

- Make a timetable of your day showing the time on analogue and digital clocks for each activity.
- Draw a Viking longboat out of 2D shapes and label their properties.
- Find out the dates of when Viking Kings ruled. How long was their life span? How did they rule?
- Work out how many miles the Saxons/Vikings/Anglo Saxons travelled from their homeland to their settlements in Kent.

Literacy Task

- Write a description of a Viking warrior. Consider appearance, clothing and personality.
- Write a diary entry for a day in the life of a Viking.
 Consider how they spent their days.
- Research a Viking god/goddess and write a profile or a top trumps card.
- Research Viking words and place names. See what you can find out and create a glossary.

Topic Task

- Research Viking longboats. Whose role was it to make them? What was their purpose? What materials were used?
- Create a Viking shield, helmet or weapon.
- What major events in history happened during the Viking era?
- Research the Kings of Viking times. Can you create a timeline of rulers?

Creative Task

- Make a long boat out of junk.
- Build a sandcastle and take a photograph. How creative can you be?
- Bake a Viking themed cake.
