

Friends of Orchard Vale update - October 2018

Firstly, could we thank you for supporting the Friends of Orchard Vale fund raising events. You might be asking yourself "Where does the money go?"

With your help we have raised a fantastic amount of money to support the school. Here are some of the things these funds have been spent on:

- We have pledged £3000 to help replace the boat in the playground and the adventure trail. These replacements are already in motion.
- We pledged £2000 to help kick start funding for a MUGA (multi use games area) to enable all year round use of the school playing field.
- We commit to pay 25% of all trip costs. This is deducted before you see the price you pay. We have recently transferred £1028 to cover the trips for this term.
 - Key Stage 1's visit to Paignton Zoo who are studying animals this term.
 - Years 3 and 4 visits to Heatree Activity Centre to take part in a Stone Age Roundhouse experience.
 - Years 5 and 6 who are studying world wars and conflicts will be visiting the Fleet Air Arm Museum
 - We are buying £250 worth of maths resources for reception and nursery. These guys are not having a trip this term so it is only fair that they have some money spent on them too.
- We will be buying toothbrushes for the children in Reception to Year 6 to use during the Oral Health day.
