Headteacher's message

Dear Parents/Carers

We hope the children are looking forward to the half term break - don't forget that tomorrow, Friday, 22nd October, is a non-pupil day.

The children have done so well reaching the end of this half term. They have settled beautifully into the school routines and remembering expectations while trying to stay safe with the increased hygiene. There is still some work to do in terms of catching up with gaps in learning but all children are showing great attitudes to their learning and their work and this will go a long way to filling these gaps as quickly as we can. We are all so proud of all their achievements so far and I know we have a brilliant school year ahead of us if we are able to sustain this.

Thank you all for your help in keeping Covid-19 cases at OV down to a minimum. Please could we ask you to continue calling 119 for advice should your child exhibit <u>any</u> Covid symptoms. They will advise you if you need to book a PCR test. We will continue to encourage the children to practice good hygiene whilst in school.

Upon our return, on 1st November, please could we ask for your help in keeping our children safe when they have been handed over to you at the end of school. Please could you encourage the children to leave the school site promptly and sensibly, watching out for cars when crossing the road, not climbing on the tree in the turning circle and not playing on anything that isn't designated play equipment.


Halloween themed craft activities will also be available in the visitor centre every day from 10am to 5pm.
