| <b>wild plants</b>   | A <b>wild plant seed</b> grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows. |
| <b>garden plants</b> | <b>Garden plants</b> are plants that people choose to grow in their gardens.                           |
| <b>weed</b>          | <b>Weeds</b> are <b>wild plants</b> that grow in places where people don't want them.                  |
| <b>deciduous</b>     | A <b>deciduous tree</b> loses its <b>leaves</b> each year.   |
| <b>evergreen</b>     | An <b>evergreen tree</b> keeps its green <b>leaves</b> all year round, even in the winter.             |



### What a Plant Needs





- If a seed is not **warm** enough, it will not germinate
- Germination is when the seed starts to sprout in to a plant
- If a plant does not have enough **light**, it will grow to be tall and flimsy as it searches for light. It will probably die.
- If a plant is not **watered** enough, its stem will be fragile and have very dry leaves. It will eventually die.

## Pablo Picasso (1881 1973)

- He was a Spanish artist and Sculptor.
- He was a part of the 'cubism' movement. (using geometric shapes in his work. I.e squares, triangles etc)
- Picasso previously held the record for most expensive painting ever sold-"Le Rêve" \$155 million.



The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (also referred to as the UK) is made up of four countries:




The capital city of Scotland is Edinburgh.
