Nursery this week:

This week we have been learning about spiders. In maths we have been putting 8 peg legs on each spider, have been very busy counting spiders and matching them to the correct numerals. This is the proposed schedule; final details will be dependent upon the number of entries each tournament receives and will be confirmed via email prior to the tournament.

General Rules

- All players play at their own risk.
- Normal rounders rules apply; these will be confirmed in the welcome pack that each team will be given upon entering.
- All teams must register **all** players by completing a team sheet. These will be provided on receipt of your **entry form** and **DEPOSIT payment**, and should be submitted to the Registration Desk on the day of the tournament.
- Players can guest for other teams throughout the course of the tournament. *However, you may not use a guest player as a bowler.*
- Both tournaments will contain mixed teams, with a specified maximum number of male players per team, see below for details for each tournament.
- All female teams will be accepted.
- Each team has a maximum of 15 and a minimum of 6 players. No more than 9 players to be on the field at any one time.
- If a team plays with less than 9 players, *no batters may receive a life.*



- For reasons of health and safety, the consumption of alcohol by players whilst a game is in progress is prohibited.
- For reasons of health and safety all players must be suitably attired for rounders, with particular reference to footwear and jewellery. Trainers or similar must be worn and on no account will flip flops or bare feet be allowed. Large jewellery items should be removed and smaller items taped.

Family Tournament Rules

- Minimum age 8, players aged 17 and under must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult appointed by their parent or guardian to be responsible for their safety throughout the tournament.
- At all times, players on the field should include at least 2 players of primary school age, and a further 2 players of 15 years or younger. The remaining five players can include a maximum of 3 males.
- Those at primary school may use a tennis racquet and ball instead of a rounders bat and ball if needed.

Adult Tournament Rules

- Minimum age 14, 17 and under must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult appointed by their parent or guardian to be responsible for their safety throughout the tournament.
- If a mixed team – there should be a minimum of 4 female players on the pitch at any one time.

Privacy Policy and Terms & Conditions

- A copy of our Privacy Policy can be found on our Facebook page, North Devon Rounders.
- Photographs and video will be taken during the tournament. These are used for publicity purposes for us, North Devon Rounders, as well as Rounders England, Somerset Activity & Sports Partnership and Active Devon. Individuals will be able to consent to be included in any photographs and video that are taken on the team sheet. Individuals who do not consent to be included may be asked to wear a bib for identification purposes.
- Entries are accepted at the discretion of the North Devon Rounders Committee.
