Introduce children to rainforests around the world. They will learn what they are, where they are, what they contain and who lives there! Along the way they will develop their skills by creating reports and creating their own rainforests. They will use local woods to inspire writing.

Visit from Fireman and/or to Fire Station.

Investigate Great Fire of London from the 17th Century! Contrast firesafety from the past with today. Study the buildings of the period and create your own buildings. Study the rhymes and songs of the time; study St Paul's Cathedral and make sketches, prints, clay sculptures and 3D models. Burn models in Forest School. Enthused by the famous diarists Samuel Pepys and John Evelyn, write diaries and read them to younger children. Learn about the food of the time and bake bread.
